Charity Reputation:

- Charity Not Rated by GuideStar or Charity Navigator. This is not uncommon for a charity of this size.
- Charity reported a net loss in 2020, but retained an asset balance exceeding two years of operation income. This was not an uncommon scenario during the pandemic fundraising crunch. Given recent awards, publicity, and continued operations, this charity seems on solid footing.
- Charity is classified as primarily an animal welfare organization, but this misses the dual veteran's support mission.

ROG Evaluation Notes:

- A contribution to this organization will greatly improve lives.
- Contributions to this charity primary come from corporate partnerships.
- The top individuals compensated by this charity receive very modest pay.
- This charity's operating costs are reasonable and they apply a very high percentage of donations to direct action. For example, puppy/dog supplies are their second highest expense item after modest compensation.
- Fundraising costs for this charity are reasonable.
- The charity offers numerous donation opportunities, including sponsorship of a dog, sponsorship for a veteran placement, and recurring monthly giving.
- This charity would be transformed by a significant, long-term charitable investment.

Summary ROG Evaluation: In our opinion, this is an "A" rating charity. Contributions will have proven, life-changing impact and a very high percentage of contributions go directly to the core need.

Impact to the Sample Family's Philanthropic Mission: This charity is a strong fit for Jane Sample's charitable goals supporting veterans and animal welfare. It should be strongly considered for long-term investment.
